A \$750 Undergraduate Scholarship will be awarded by Catholic Daughters of the Americas, Court #1692 to **two** (2) graduating/graduated high school seniors from Our Lady of Angels Parish.

Seven hundred fifty dollars will be paid from the Scholarship Fund to the college or trade school of the recipient's choice. Each scholarship will close when the \$750 has been used by the recipient, or when the recipient ceases to be a full time student.

Applications can be picked up from the Rectory office at 565 W Hermiston Avenue or an application can be emailed upon request. The completed application package needs to be returned to the Rectory office no later than **Friday, May 7th**.

Selection for recipients of the two (2) scholarships will be determined using the following system:

25% Academic Achievement

25% Financial Need

50% Parish Involvement

The selection of the recipients will be determined after the Scholarship Committee reviews all applications. Winners will be announced at the planned Mass honoring our graduating seniors. All applicants will be contacted via mail as well.
